On September 7th 2017, IMSolutions implemented a new Employee Recognition Program called YouEarnedIt. IMSolutions will work with the YouEarnedIt platform to better engage our employees by enabling employees to send real-time recognition, receive meaningful rewards, and provide insightful employee analytics that will build a stronger company culture.

I am sure most IMSolutions employees are familiar with credit cards or rewards cards given out by a plethora of merchants hoping to entice us to shop at their store or use their credit card. YouEarnedIt is really no different with the exception that, in this case, you know that your performance is never going to go unnoticed in the workplace. YouEarnedIt has an online administrative dashboard which is easy to view and gage performance statistics.

How it works is simple! IMSolutions employees can send and receive real-time recognition, tag it with a company's core values, and use the activity feed to keep a pulse on the great things our coworkers and peers are doing across the company. Along with this recognition, employees receive rewards points which can be spent on rewards ranging from hundreds of digital gift cards, thousands of products, custom company experiences or swag, and ways to give back to meaningful causes.

Office 365 provides the ability to see if others are editing the document you're using, synchronize documents with your desktop, broadcast PowerPoint presentations, and check documents in and out of your online document library. You will never run out of space using Office 365.
